**Directions:**

**From Fort Collins:** Head North on Hwy. 287. Continue for about 14 miles North of Livermore/Old Forks Restaurant. Pass the closed Virginia Dale Post Office & Café on the top of the hill. Turn right onto County Rd 43F, by the historical marker. Look for signs/balloons to the Stage Station.

**From Laramie:** Head South on Hwy. 287. Continue past the Virginia Dale rest stop. Turn left onto County Road 43F, just past the Abbey of St. Walburga. Look for signs/balloons.
